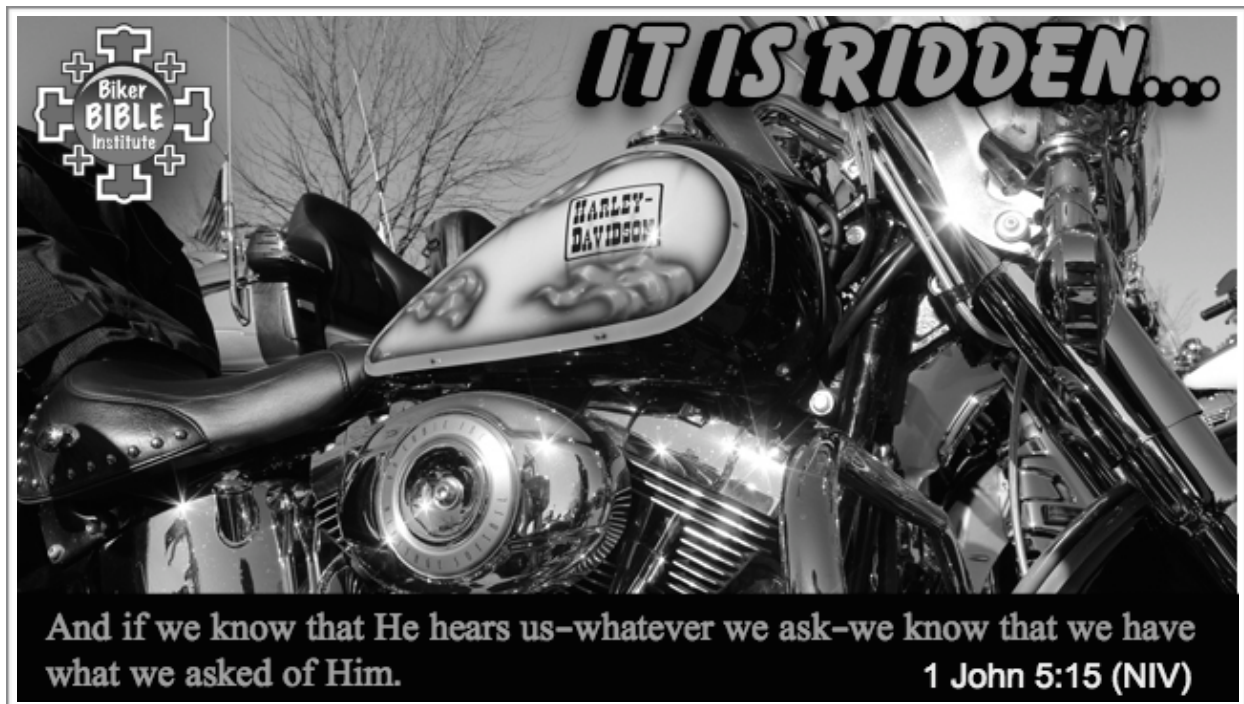

KEY VERSE: 1 John 5:15

And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him. (1 John 5:15, NIV)

BACKGROUND ...

This is not a Bible verse about "a genie in a bottle" who answers three wishes for us. The key here is the part that says, "If we know that He hears us." We don't know that unless we have been walking (riding) with Him. We only know this through faith and experience. And when we reach that point in our relationship with Him, we find that we are asking Him, "Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven." How's your

relationship with Almighty God today? Jesus wants to make it even better! Follow Him to our Father's throne today! Let's talk!

3. Why is this Bible passage important to bikers today? What can we learn from it?
4. How does this passage apply in our world today? What's going on around us that this message might impact?
5. What other questions would you like to ask the group or what other points would you like to make?

DISCIPLESHIP CHALLENGE: Based on the Scripture and your group discussions ...

1. What do you need to start doing in your life?
2. What should you probably stop doing?
3. What things could you pray about changing with God's help?

NOTE: The "Disciple Challenge" is to actually take action on at least one of the questions above!

CLOSING COMMENTS ...

- What were some of the Key Thoughts and ideas from today's group discussion? What do you remember? What stands out as important?
- If you could suggest one thing to the rest of the group to take away from this discussion, what would it be?
